

ABOUT BLUE ROCK SPRINGS PARK

BLUE ROCK SPRINGS PARK is a historic site with large picnic areas, open turf play areas, children's play equipment, a small lake and island with ducks and peacocks, off street parking, and restrooms. For more information on Blue Rock Springs Park, visit their website at www.gvrd.org/bluerock.html

DIRECTIONS to Blue Rock Springs Park from I-80 North or South:

Take the Columbus Parkway exit. Follow signs until the roadway merges with Columbus Parkway. Continue on Columbus Parkway for approximately 2 miles. The park is located on the north (left-hand) side of the road.

DIRECTIONS to Blue Rock Springs Park From CA-37 East:

Take CA-37 East towards Vallejo / Napa. Take the Columbus Parkway exit. Follow signs to Columbus Parkway crossing the I-80. The road then becomes Columbus Parkway. Continue for approximately 2 miles. Park is located on the north (left-hand) side of the road.

CLASS ENTRY DETAILS:

■ The following classes will be offered: Novice Draft, Open Draft, Novice Brace Draft, and Open Brace Draft

- There will be a limit of **24 entries each day** for this Draft Test.
- Entry fees are \$35 for each single dog team / \$45 for each brace team
- A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a brace team and then stapled together. Even though two entry forms are required for each brace team, each brace team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
- If you want to be able to move dogs that pass a Novice class up to an Open class on the second day, you must include a weight certificate with your Novice entry.
- If more than 24 entries are received, they will be prioritized in the following order:

1. BMD – Untitled

3. Other breeds – Untitled

2. BMD - Titled

4. Other breeds – Titled

(Note that "titled" means titled in the entered class.)

A random drawing will be held for each group that exceeds the Test limit per BMDCA Draft Test Regulations. Entries exceeding the total Test limit shall be assigned to an alternate list in the order in which they were drawn.

- All Entrants and Alternates will be notified within 48 hours of the close of entries by phone or e-mail.
- Entrants must notify the Draft Test Secretary if a dog has earned a title in the entered class, including if the title is earned after the entry has been submitted.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES:

Entries close at 7:00 p.m., Pacific Time, on Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at the Draft Test Secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the current BMDCA Draft Test regulations.

IMPORTANT DETAILS FOR EXHIBITORS:

- Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test (birth date on or before May 14 and/or May 15, 2009).
- Draft Dog class entrants must include a veterinary certificate with the entry form stating the dog's name and weight. This certificate must be dated within 60 days prior to May 14 and/or 15, 2011.
- Handlers must provide their own draft rig, freight load, harness, and tie downs (or other means of securing a load in their particular draft rig).
- Freight Haul Weight Loads:
 - ➤ In Novice Draft, the weight required is 20 lbs.
 - > In Open Draft, the weight required is the weight of the dog rounded down to the nearest 10 lbs.
 - ➤ In Novice Brace Draft, the weight required is 40 lbs. per team.
 - > In Open Brace Draft, the weight required is the sum of the Open weight for each dog.

HANDLERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN WEIGHTS FOR THE FREIGHT HAUL.

- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in the Draft Test. Refund of entry fees for bitches entered who come in season after the closing date of the Test may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Test Secretary postmarked before the opening day of the Test, or by giving it to the Test Secretary before the start of the Test.
- Brace participants require individual entry forms for each dog, and they must be submitted together. Only one entry fee required per brace team.
- The two dogs of a brace team need not be owned by the same person.
- Move-ups are allowed per the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations.

Please bring chairs, x-pens, water, weather protection, and any other equipment you might need. Please be a responsible dog owner and pick up after your dog(s).

BERNESE MOUNTAIN DOG CLUB OF AMERICA DRAFT TEST PURPOSE

Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Bernese Mountain Dogs in a working capacity involving hauling. The Bernese Mountain Dog has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting from both inherent ability and training that are applicable to realistic work situations. Efficiency in accomplishment of tasks is essential. It is also desirable that the dog evidence willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.
