The 20,625-acre Caribou Wilderness lies on the eastern slope of Mt. Tehama, a volcano on the eastern border of Lassen National Park. The Caribou Wilderness is a gentle, rolling, lake-dotted and forested plateau predominantly covered with lodgepole pine. (See the link to the trip description.)
